

NOTICE OF ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a General Election will be held on Tuesday, September 20, 2022 for the following Officers of the Young Leaders Political Action Committee:

PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS (FULL TERM OF TWO YEARS)

ASSISTANT PRESIDENT (FULL TERM OF FIVE MONTHS AS ASSISTANT PRESIDENT, WITH POSSIBILITY OF RENEWAL, AND TWO TOTAL YEARS AS A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS)

The term of office is from the time the special election results are certified until November 5, 2024. All applicants must be over ten years of age, under nineteen years of age, reside within the State of California and willing to make an enthusiastic commitment to the governance of the Young Leaders Political Action Committee, and the representation of all students within the State of California.

Each applicant will have the opportunity to present their qualifications and their candidacy in writing and/or other electronic means, using an electronic PDF file, which all registered voters will have access to.

Applications must be returned by 5 p.m., Wednesday, August 31, 2022. Applications are available upon request by contacting the Inquiries Department on the Young Leaders Political Action Committee website, via Instagram, via email or US mail if requested. Applications must be returned to both the general Young Leaders PAC inbox (YoungLeadersPAC@gmail.com) and the Supervisor of Elections no later than 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 31st. If emailed, time of email must be 5:00 p.m. or earlier. Extensions may be given upon the request of the candidate and with the approval of the Supervisor of Elections only if such an extension is requested at a time when the incumbent has not filed.

Voting is scheduled to take place online beginning approximately the morning of Saturday, September 17, 2022. Polls will close at 7:00 p.m. Pacific Time on Tuesday, September 20, and results will be certified by the Supervisor of Elections thereafter.

All applicants must be between the ages of ten and nineteen, have lived in the State of California upon submission of their application for at least thirty-one days.

Please answer ALL the following questions on a separate document, and submit your answers to the general Young Leaders PAC inbox AND the Interim Supervisor of Elections June Cutter, Esq. (Information Found on pg. 5)

What is your name? Please write your name the way you want it to be displayed on the ballot and on all official documents. Include your middle initial, middle name, suffix, and/or nickname if you prefer. (For instance, if your name is Jack Smith, but you would *prefer* official documents to display your name as John D. "Jack" Smith, jr., please write the latter.)

Which office are you seeking election to: President of the Board of Governors or Assistant President?

What is your home address and how long have you lived there?

Do you affiliate with a political party? If so, which? If given the choice between the Democratic Party and the Republican Party, if elected, which party would you conference with?

How old are you? In what school district is your school located, and in what grade are you enrolled for the 2022-2023 school year?

What are your occupational goals, if any? Is there a university you are hoping to attend after high school? What occupation do you intend on pursuing?

What community service, extra curricular, or political experience do you have?

As a student, what do you see as the three biggest issues facing our state today, and how would you approach them?

If you were to help create a set of norms for any leadership team, what is something that should definitely be on it?

Name a public figure (in politics, in pop culture, or in history) who inspires you.

In this section, please make your pitch to voters in no more than 250 words as to why they should vote for you.

Here are some questions you might want to consider, but you are not obligated to answer in your statement. Why do you want to be elected to this specific position on the Board of Governors of the Young Leaders Political Action Committee? What do you feel you will bring to the position? Why should voters elect you? Is there anything specific in your background, education, experience, or interests that qualify you to be a Member of the Board of Governors more than your opponents? What ideas will you bring to the Chambers of the Board of Governors?

In this section, choose no more than three words that describe your involvement in your community, hobbies, or current job. Proper nouns count as one word. You may not use opinionated adjectives like "exemplary" or "outstanding." This is called your **ballot designation**, and will appear under your name when you run.

Examples of ballot designations that have been used by YLPAC student candidates in the past include:

- San Francisco Community Leader
- Worship Leader/Volunteer
- Student/Hockey Player
- LGBTQ+ Rights Advocate
- Entrepreneur/Baker/Songwriter
- Medical Volunteer/Athlete
